On the date of April 17th, R/O conducted an interview with regarding information that he and others may be involved in several grain elevator/fertilizer plant burglaries which occured on the counties east side.

While speaking with he made a comment regarding his current arrest stating that he could not understand why he was arrested for what two other persons had said he had done.

about his armed robbery arrest, I needed to advise him that he had already been read his miranda rights and he had stated that he wished to have an attorney present. R/O continued that R/O had not begun this conversation to speak about his arrest, but rather his possible involvment with the county burglaries.

R/O advised that if there was any conversation regarding his armed robbery arrest, he would be the person to initiate that conversation, not R/O.

R/O stated that R/O did not wish to be responsible for another agencies investigation by saying something that should not be said.

R/O advised that " I don't want to mess anything up for anyone.", and replied " It's already messed up without you getting involved."

At the end of the interview, while awaiting for a Correctional Officer to come and take back to the jail area of the Sheriff's Department, R/O and continued talking and the following was said by R/O and

BAILEY: Are you and still together ?

Yea

BAILEY: It's been quite sometime, but the last time that I saw

she was working at Cubs.

: No, she's working at Schooners.

BAILEY: I thought that the two of you were going to get married once you got my last arrest behind you.

Well, thats were the money was suppose to go, now its got to go to the fucking attorney.

At this time th Correctional Officer arrived and R/O advised that if he needed to speak to R/O about anything, he just needed to send down a request.

At this time the Correctional Officer took custody of and lead him to the jail area.

This conversation took place with in interview room B, C.I.D., McLean County Sheriff's Department, between 1:10 p.m. and 1:25 p.m.
