ON SUNDAY 03-31-91 AT APP 20:18 MYSELF (B-2) AND WILLIAMS (A2) WERE DISPATCHED TO A HOLD UP ALARM AT LINDEN & E. EMPIRE CLARK STATION 902 E. EMPIRE. I APPROACHED FROM LINDEN NORTH FROM LOCUST ST. TURNED HEAD LIGHTS OFF AT LINDEN & CHESNUT. I PARKED MY SQUAD IN THE PARKING LOT JUST SOUTH OF THE STATION SHIELDED BY TWO OR THREE PARKED CARS. AS I OBSERVED THE STATION THERE WAS KNOW MOVEMENT INSIDE.

THERE WAS A OLDER MODEL CAR ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE LOT A W/M WAS PUTTING AIR IN THE TIRES. WILLIAMS STATED HE WAS 10:23 (ARRIVED AT SCENE) I STARTED WALKING ACROSS EMPIRE ON THE FAR EAST SIDE OF THE CLARK STATION LOT. AS I WALKED TOWARD THE DOOR AT AN ANGLE A SILVER OR GREY PICKUP TRUCK PULLED INTO THE LOT UP IN FRONT OF THE DOOR. W/M PASSENGER GOT OUT AND STARTED FOR THE DOOR. AT THIS POINT I OBSERVED THREW THE GLASS DOOR A TENNA-SHOE STICKING OUT FROM BEHIND THE COUNTER I TOLD THE W/M TO GET BACK IN HIS TRUCK. TOLD W/M DRIVER TO GO ACROSS THE STREET AND WAIT THERE.

I walked out OF THE station and Requested Rescue and possibly THE coronER. I attempted TO find a pulse AFTER I WENT BACK IN none was Detectable I then left TO have my squad TO start sewing off THE car.

Newton, with ofc. Cook, searched an alley between Linden and Eastholme, from Empire to Emerson for the suspect and/or evidence. After this search, Sgt. Cox and Sgt. O'Brien assigned ofc. Newton and ofc. Pelo to conduct a neighborhood canvas. Following is a list of homes ofc. Newton contacted and the results.

[Redacted] Bloomington - [Redacted] and [Redacted] - they said that approx. 5 min before they heard sirens, they heard tires squeeling in the area of the Clark Station, but they saw nothing. This interview was conducted in a parking lot at the Southeast corner of Empire + Linden.
